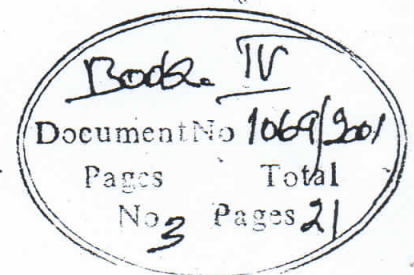

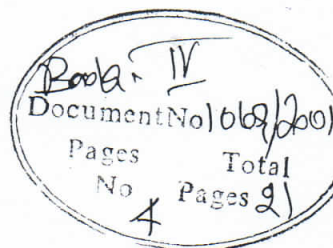

## OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST:

### 3.1. TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP COURSE FEES TO OUTSTANDING STUDENT AMONG ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION TO PURSUE PROFESSIONAL/ TECHNICAL EDUCATION IN ALL SCHOOLS/COLLEGES INDIA.

17. To run educational institutions by Tamil Nadu Government Educational Rules, obtaining Government Recognition and aid etc., from the authorities concerned.

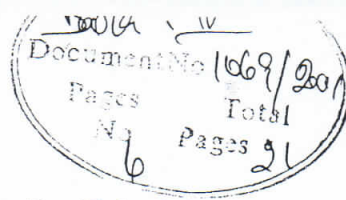
#### ANCILLIARY OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

- b) To employ, surgical, medical and pharmaceutical officers, nurse, doctors and attendants and provide and supply to other charitable medical institutions all medical surgical and pharmaceutical appliance van's for transport or patients from homes to hospitals or vice versa.
- c) To educate and maintain medical students and nurse and other paramedical personal and way of classes seminars, lectures, symposiums and workshops etc., in the prevention and treat and to the disease. To provide yoga Meditation Activities.
- d) To award grant, scholarship, fellowships and similar financial assistance or encouragement for advancement of Research in Medical Science, Engineering.

- d) The trust intends to work for the down trodden poor women & children.
- e) To rehabilitate downtrodden, weaker sections of the society, handicapped, ex-servicemen, and women by training, education providing suitable and arranging for self-employment scheme.

- f) To plan, promote, undertake and assist programs for agricultural development Animal Husbandry market processing, supply and storage of agricultural products, small scale industry cottage industry, Agro industry, providing assistance, conduct of survey research study, and other activities which will enable man and women for their better living, help them to improve their standard of living.
- g) To establish schools, colleges, technical and other Institutions, professional colleges, technical and other institutions for imparting general, academic technical or professional education students at large as under laws and rules in force.
- h) To provide, art, culture, handicraft and traditional activities.
- i) To promote employment to women, rehabilitation enters partnership among women, educational training and financial assistance.
- j) To rehabilitate displaced persons and to provide or assist them in finding necessary modes of sustenance.
- k) To investigate the cause of displacement, and disturbance and to compile information on such causes and to do what is necessary to prevent the recurrence of such Causes of Displacement.
- l) The Trust will give stipend to the Children of socially affected women. It also draw some useful welfare schemes for the divorced women, socially backward women, women affected by some chronic incurable discusses, women affected by AIDS, women from Red Light Area. The Trust will try to get all the financial helps, agricultural lands for cultivation and residential plots, house from the State and Central Government and it also form "Women's Rehabilitation Centre, and give training's like, tailoring, printing, cooking, house keeping and house cleaning etc., so that the women can got on appointment and can stand on their own legs in the society with more courage and confidence. The affected women 's hostel facilities will be arranged to the outstation women's.
- m) To purchase land, agricultural lands, or acquire lands buildings or to take on lease of lands buildings act run the above activities.



- n) To do to do all such lawful things as are incidental or ancillary or conducive to the attainment of any of the above objects for the benefits of community. The Trust shall provide educational helpless.
- o) To identify the Socioeconomic conditions and need of the vulnerable section, labourers in organized and unorganized sectors, consumers, women, children, orphans, aged sick, physically, visually and mentally challenged and all ailing section of Indian Society.

### 3.5. TO PROMOTE AND CARRY OUT THE OBJECTIVES;

- 1) Trust is empowered to apply for and receive grants and contributions both from internal and External Agencies Institutions, State and Central Government as the case may be.
- 2) Trust is empowered to purchase, lease of rent property as and when required to promote and execute the objects.
- 3) The Trust empowered to raise loans and such funds from financial institutions and government.
- 4) The Trust may enter into contract or agreement or any other transactions for the purpose of promoting the aims.
- 5) The Trust is empowered to take on lease, License, hire or otherwise required to hold manage, administer deal with movable and immovable property that the Board deems necessary.
- 6) To sell, lease, mortgage, charge pledge, hypothecate, transfer or otherwise, deal with all properties funds and assets, or the trust as the board may deem fit.
- 7) To appoint, persons representatives, agents on other works on such conditions as may be thought necessary by the Trust.
- 8) The Trust funds acquired or earned shall be solely utilized towards fulfilling of the objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payments to trustees by way of profit interest or dividends or otherwise. The Program and benefits shall be open to all those who need as the case may be.

### 3.6 OBJECTIVES OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITY:

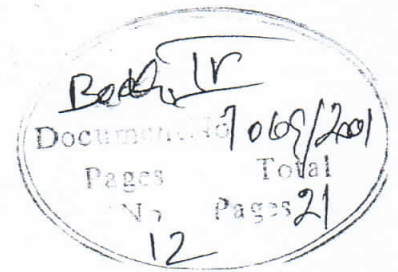

  - c) To adopt backward villages and to implement welfare schemes for the development of such backward village.
  - d) To receive assist food clothes and shelters displaced persons.
3. To dig and construct or aid in making bore wells, reservoirs, tanks.
  4. To establish maintain, run shelter and medical relief to affected people.
  5. To accept foreign contribution on behalf of the trust and utilize such contributions for the purpose of carrying on medical relief to the persons.
  6. To import hospital goods by way of purchase or receive as donation which are necessary for the purpose of carrying on medical relief to the persons.
  7. To important machinery receive by way of donation from foreign countries equipment's for the purpose of research, especially in the field of medical, scientific and research foundations.
  8. To get necessary exemptions license, registration from the government in order to implement the aforesaid purpose early.

- ix) Foreign contribution/donations/gifts in the form of article currency whether India or foreign security, subject to the provisions of Foreign Contributions (Regulations) Act 1956 and the Rules framed thereunder.

  - iv) Enter into correspondence with all parties.
  - v) He shall authorities all payments to the treasure and the inform shall any after taking the acquirement.
- 2) He is empower to be present before authorize to give written petition, to correspond to maintain registers, files etc., of the Trust to regularize the aims, plans and activities of the Trust.
- 3) He is also empower to convene Trust Board meeting, to set up office to appoint clerk maintains, registers, files etc., of the Trust to regularize the aims, plans and activities of the Trust.

9.3 **POWER OF THE TREASURER:**

He will be anchorage of the account and receipts for the amount in his custody, get the authorization of the Secretary for the disbursements, or money, maintain the accounts, submit the money accounts to the Secretary, and arrange for the audit of the accounts.

The Trust's Treasurer can keep the money of the Trust within him up to limit Rs.5,000/- In order to meet the incidental expenses to be incurred for the purpose of security. Beyond the limit of Rs.,5,000/- for incurring expenditure the Treasurer has to obtain the prior approval of the founders for such expenditure.

## 10. POWER OF THE FOUNDERS:

The Founders herein shall hold office at his pleasure and on the Vacation of office by any one or more of the founder herein on their own violation or by death or otherwise the remaining founders herein shall appoint the legal heirs of the deceased founder. They are also entitled to enjoy all the rights enjoyed by other founders.

The founders have got full right and power at any time to alter, or change the nominee member of the trust board and also to remove, and change the member of trust if they decide to do so. Further the majority of the founders has got full authority either to add or reject any resolutions to be brought by the trustees before the trust board every founder has got equal right and of liberty in respect of each activity.

## 11. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees shall hold the trust fund of the following terms:

The Trustees shall be entitled for reimbursement of all expenses incurred by them including travelling expenses for the purposes of the trust or attending the meeting of the Trustees and are also indemnified in respect of all acts done in the course of carrying the activity of the trust. The Trustees are entitled to remuneration.

The Founders & Trustees shall pass or give solution by circulation in case of an urgent issue. They may make rules for regulation of their meeting and the trustees may repeal later any rules pursuant to this clause.

1. To manage the trust fund and collect and recover the interest, dividends and other income there of and to pay and discharge out of the income of the trust fund all expenses and charges for collecting and recovering the income of the trust fund and all other costs. Charges and expenses and out going of and incidental to the trust created by these presents and the administration they're of.

2. To pay or utilize the income of the Trust called the net income of the Trust and at the discretion of the trustees the corpus of the public charitable purpose set out here in above in such shares and proportions and in such manner in all respects as the trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit. The Trustees herein shall have all the power necessary or incidental for effectual carrying out the objects of the trust.
3. To apply the Trust money to effectuate one objects or some of the objects of the trust in preference to other object(s). To discontinue the applications of trust funds to the objects and divert the funds to another objects of the trust.
4. To receive donations wither by cash, a kind of legacy or any other means from foreign countries or in India by way of corpus of for on revenue account.
5. In case it is decided to render financial or other aid to any person or institution within the scope of the objects, to decide the terms and conditions which shall be complied with by such person or institutions.
6. To determine if necessary, the terms and conditions on which any donation, subscriptions, scholarships or prizes or medals are to be given by the Trust.
7. To expand the funds of the trust in such manner as they consider must beneficial for the objects and purposes of the trust.
8. To acquire agriculture, land build upon pull down, rebuild, add to alter, repaid, cultivate or improve sell or dispose of any land, building or premises for the use of the trust, and to acquire other movable intangible benefits of immovable properties.

### BANKING ACCOUNTS:

The Trust Board shall open one or more Bank accounts in the name of the Trust. **ADVISORY BOARD:**

The Founder and Trustees herein may maintain a list of advisors for better administration of any particular objects of engaging their services. The Trustees shall have liberty to fix remuneration for the services rendered by the advisors.

**16 GENERAL FUNCTION:**

1. This Trust is irrevocable. If the Trust hereby constitutes fail for any reason in the opinion of the Founder Trustees of the trust the net assets of the Trust both movable and immovable shall be handed over to any public charitable trust as decided by the majority of the Founder's only.
2. In the event of closure of winding up dissolution of the trust all its assets and liabilities, if any shall be transferred to another trust which has similar objects and enjoying Exemption U/s. 11 and 80G of the Income Tax Act. 1961.
3. The Trust shall invest its income available for investments from time to time in specific mode of investments as per section 13(I) (d) read with sec. (ii) 5 of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
4. The Income and funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of its income shall be utilized for payment to trustees by way of remuneration, profit, interest, dividends etc., in section 13(I) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
5. The funds of the Trust would not be applied for any religious purposes or given to religious institutions.
6. Any amendment to the instrument would be carried only with the approval of Director of Income Tax (Exemption).
7. Acquisition/alienation of immovable property shall be done with prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemptions).
8. The benefits of the Trust are open to all in the society at large irrespective of caste, creed, religion, sex etc.,
9. The activities and functions of the Trust shall be utilized be utilized only towards charitable purpose and not for any profit motive.






